Carbon for Farmers Voucher Program

Step 1 Farmers apply



- Complete the simple application form on SmartyGrants.
- Include a quote from your service provider/s.

Applications close 29 September 2023.

Step 2 Applications are assessed and recipients announced



- The Department of Primary Industries and Regional Development assesses each application. Successful applicants are announced.

Online grant readiness sessions held for:

- successful farmers
- service providers.

Step 3 Develop a Carbon Farming Plan



- Farmer works with their service provider/s to develop a property specific Carbon Farming Plan.
- Service provider submits the Plan to the Department and the farmer.

Step 4 Provider submits the Carbon Farming Plan



- Farmer provides feedback and completes satisfaction declaration.
- The Department undertakes service completion checks of the Plan, then informs the farmer and service provider to finalise the invoice process.

Step 5 Provider invoices farmer and the Department



- Farmer acquits the voucher via SmartyGrants.
- Service provider invoices the Department for the approved voucher amount.
- Service provider invoices farmer for the agreed cash co-contribution.
