



The Optimising Fodder Options on Mixed Farming Systems Project is supported through the Australian Government's National Landcare Program and is designed to increase summer ground cover to:

- fill summer feed gaps, and
- improve soil health.

The project will support mixed farmers in the Wheatbelt NRM region to develop whole farm summer cover plans that consider a range of pasture, summer cropping and forage options, to meet pre-defined livestock production goals.

To enable this, Wheatbelt NRM will partner with farmers, local grower groups, corporate agriculture, and other organisations to establish eight demonstration sites across the region during 2019/2020.

The purpose of the demonstration sites are to provide a wider audience of mixed farmers with a reference as to how whole farm summer cover plans fit within Wheatbelt mixed farming systems to both improve soil health and meet production objectives.

Demonstration site hosts will be supported by a farm planner/advisor to develop the whole farm summer cover plans. The plans will identify the best mix of feed options for each property to ultimately reduce the reliance on hand feeding and improve ground cover during the summer period. By selection of demonstration farms across different soil types and rainfall zones it is intended that the full spectrum of summer feed alternatives will be considered.

Extension events and wider industry learning will support the demonstration sites. They will include opportunities for industry discussion on the topic, and include the latest information on different fodder options, livestock health and market trends affecting livestock production.




