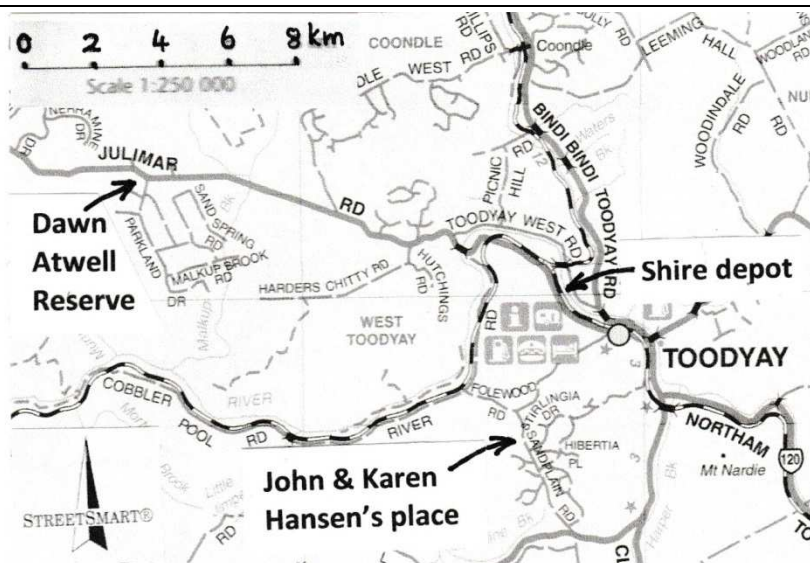
Combined SWAN/Master TreeGrower course field day
